



New to the ranks of small holiday trailers is the "Wessex", shown above. Mounted on an angle-steel chassis, fitted with four tubular corner legs and a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ -in. ball hitch, the single skinned body of tempered masonite on a timber frame has a lift-up rear end which gives access to the interior and provides additional cover. In standard form, the "Wessex" is equipped with two fixed windows and two built-in ventilators. With a shelf, two tube-and-canvas beds and a cabinet, as shown, the price works out at £99 5s. and the weight amounts to approx.  $3\frac{1}{2}$ -cwt. Many additional extras are available including tent extensions for the rear end. The makers are Wessex Industries (Poole) Ltd., West Street, Poole.
